Re: Willow Creek Permit Stipulations

As per your request in your June 13, 1990 letter, UDOGM hereby approves an extension of time to complete the stipulations attached to the Willow Creek Permit (ACT 007/002). The extension will be for an additional 30 days or until July 25, 1990, which is 60 days from the date of permit approval.

Also in your letter, you objected to the following stipulations being placed on the permit.

- o Stipulation UMC 817.111-117-(1)-(LK)
- o Stipulation UMC 817.133-(1)-(LK)
- o Stipulation UMC 817.133-(2)-(LK)
- o Stipulation UMC 817.133-(3)-(LK)

Mr. Lynn Kunzler of the Divisions technical staff reviewed your May 21, 1990 response to these stipulations and felt it was not adequate. Therefore, the stipulations were included.

We regret that the other stipulation which you object to UMC 817.48-(1,2)-(HS) was not in the list of draft stipulations. Please bear in mind that this list was only a draft. The final technical analysis (TA) was not completed until just prior to issuing the permit.
