MODIFICATION OF DIVISION
ORDER AND FINDINGS OF
PERMIT DEFICIENCY

PURSUANT to Utah Admin. R. 614-303-212, the Division directed permittee Castle Gate Coal Company to make certain permit changes enumerated in Division Order, dated December 18, 1990. The Order included deadlines for submission of specific information.

FINDINGS

1. On February 4, 1991, Castle Gate Coal Company requested an extension of the March 1, 1991, deadline for submission of information required in Items 4, 7, 8, 12, 13 and 23 of the December 18, 1990, Division Order. The extension was requested because necessary field work could not be conducted during January and February, 1991.
2. The Division has reviewed the request for extension and determined that the field work required in Items 4, 7, 8, 12, 13 and 23 of the Division Order could not have been adequately conducted in January and February, 1991.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, the Division Order dated December 18, 1991 is hereby modified to the extent that the date for the submission of information required in Items 4, 7, 8, 12, 13 and 23 is extended from March 1, 1991, to June 1, 1991.
