Re: Castle Gate Coal Company Permit #ACT/007/004* Transfer of Permit to AMAX Coal Company, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah


The Division received your application for permit transfer of the Castle Gate Permit (ACT/007/004) on January 31, 1991. Our review of the application has revealed the following deficiencies.

1. Under the section "Permits and Pending Applications", the current permit number for the Castle Gate Mine is not shown.
2. The list of violations does not contain the latest information on the Castle Gate Mine, i.e. NOV N90-18-2-1.
3. The list of owners of record of surface and subsurface areas contiguous to the permit area is inadequate. Complete addresses of the following owners of record is required: Price River Water Improvement District, Private Lots, State of Utah and United States of America.
4. The newspaper advertisement must state that the general liability insurance held by AMAX is a "claims made" policy.
5. The Division is unable to locate the \$5.00 application fee supposedly submitted with the application. Proof that the application fee has been paid is required.

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These deficiencies must be corrected before the Division can consider the application for permit transfer complete. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me or Daron Haddock, Permit Supervisor, at (801) 538-5340.
