Dear Lowell:

The purpose of this letter is to inform the Division of a change in the location of the records such as insurance, bonds, and certifications for Castle Gate Mine. The documents were moved to the office of Environmental Industrial Supply in Helper, Utah. The reason for this relocation is the inaccessibility of the office in Hardscrabble Canyon. The snow is three feet thick and rising! Paul Baker has knowledge of this relocation and concurs with the decision to move them.

In all probability, the records will never return to Hardscrabble Canyon. This spring AMAX will be removing all records and anything of value from the buildings in Hardscrabble. This removal is being done to prepare for the demolition of the facilities in the canyon by Fall of 1993 or Spring of 1994. The Mining and Reclamation Plan and any other documents which are reviewed by the Division will be located at a field office such as E.I.S. near Castle Gate.
