The Division has reviewed your letter dated November 3, 1994, which was intended to address deficiencies identified in the Division's October 28, 1994 correspondence. While most of the proposed response is acceptable it is not considered adequate to correct the deficiency. There is no measurable standard to determine where or when excessive erosion has occurred. The Division suggests that you provide permanent cross sections and designs for the diversion and a standard whereby excessive erosion can be determined. This information should be submitted in a format readily insertable to the MRP.

Please be aware that the NOV abatement timeframes and requirements are still pending. Thank you for your help during the permitting process. Please call if you have further questions.
