**Subject:** Castle Gate Refuse Removal Project

I received a call from Jim Stevenson (UMWA) who expressed some concern about what is going on at Willow Creek. I'm not sure if this is a citizen complaint or not??? He is aware of the refuse removal project, but felt that what Cyprus is doing goes beyond the project. He claims that they have culverts on site that may be used to alter the stream and that they are constructing more roads than they need to. I told him I would have an inspector go look at the operation. I also informed him that he could go along if he wanted to.

I then called Steve Demczak who said he would run up to the site this afternoon. He said he would call Mr. Stevenson and invite him to go as well. Steve will document what is taking place at the site. If Cyprus is going beyond what they are currently approved to do, we may need to take enforcement action. My feeling is that UMWA may not be aware of the large nature of the project that is approved and they are just nervous about what is going on. A trip up to the site may help them understand the project better.

I'm not aware of any environmental problem of hazard that has been created. This seemed to just be a concern about Cyprus not following the approved plan.
