An opportunity for a public hearing concerning Amax Coal Company's proposal to conduct mining operations within 100 feet of the outside right-of-way line of Highway 191 in Willow Creek Canyon was announced and a hearing was held in the Carbon County Courthouse at 3:00 p.m., May 11, 1995. This action, ACT/007/004-95B is considered a revision to the Castle Gate Mine permit.

Amax Coal is proposing a new permit for a mine (the Willow Creek Mine, PRO/007/038) that will, when approved, encompass portions of the Castle Gate Mine. The intent to conduct operations within 100 feet of Highway 191 for Willow Creek was also noticed and a hearing providing an opportunity to comment on this issue was held concomitant with the above Castle Gate hearing.

Eight persons attended the hearing (see attached list). A record was made of the hearing that shows that an opportunity to comment on the above issues was provided at 3:00 p.m. and again at approximately 3:57 p.m. All persons attending declined comments.

The hearing was closed at 4:00 p.m.
