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PURSUANT to R645-303-212, the DIVISION ORDERS the PERMITTEE, Amax Coal Company, to make the permit changes enumerated in the findings of permit deficiency in order to be in compliance with the State Coal Program. These findings of permit deficiency are to be remedied in accordance with R645-303-220.

FINDINGS OF PERMIT DEFICIENCY

The Division finds the permit deficient in that the existing Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) does not address soil salvage in the Schoolhouse Canyon Refuse Pile area and soil salvage and reclamation in the area of conveyors SC-6 and SC-7 and associated transfer buildings being constructed for the Willow Creek Mine.

Requirements


