1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a partial inspection of the Castle Gate facilities. The permit was renewed December 24, 1999. Phase II bond release applications for the Sowbelly and Hardscrabble sites were received by the Division on May 10, 2002 and are scheduled for review on July 10, 2002. A site visit for the phase two bond release application is scheduled for August 22, 2002. The #1 Adit and substations are scheduled for reclamation this fall.

2. SIGNS AND MARKERS

Signs containing the required information were posted at access points to the #1 Adit.

4A. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: DIVERSIONS

The sediment control structures were in good repair and were functioning properly at the #1 Adit.

4B. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: SEDIMENT PONDS AND IMPOUNDMENTS

The sediment pond at the #1 Adit was functioning adequately at the time of this inspection. The pond did not contain any water.

21. BONDING AND INSURANCE

The Certificate of Insurance for the Castle Gate facility has been revised, (a text change in the disclaimer), to meet the requirements of the regulations.
