1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a complete inspection of the Castle Gate facilities. The permit was renewed December 24, 1999. Phase II bond release amendments for Hardscrabble and Sowbelly were received 05/10/2002. The Phase II bond release inspection was conducted on August 22, 2002. Deficiencies were "E" mailed to Johnny on 09/10/2002 and a response was received on November 15, 2002, the review is due December 20, 2002.

2. SIGNS AND MARKERS

Signs containing the required information were posted at access points to the facilities.

4A. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: DIVERSIONS

The sediment control structures were in good repair and were functioning properly at the Castle Gate facilities.

4B. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: SEDIMENT PONDS AND IMPOUNDMENTS

There is only one sediment pond for the Castle Gate facility located at the #1 Adit. The pond was inspected for the third quarter of 2002 on 09/12/2002. The pond was reported as being stable, showing no hazards or signs of erosion. There was no water in the pond as it has been reclaimed. The primary sediment control is surface roughening.

4C. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES

Surface roughening, vegetation, diversions, and water bars are the sediment controls for the Hardscrabble, Sowbelly and #1 adit reclaimed sites. The vegetation at Sowbelly and Hardscrabble has been evaluated for phase II bond release. The sediment control measures were functioning adequately at the time of this inspection.

4D. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: WATER MONITORING

The third quarter 2002 monitoring data (entered electronically) was reviewed by the undersigned. Hard copies of the data for the adit pond discharge were reviewed. Sites B11, 12, 28, and 45 were reported as dry.

4E. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: EFFLUENT LIMITATIONS

The DMRs at the #1 adit indicated no discharge for September, October, and November2002. The adit and sediment pond were reclaimed in December eliminating the DMR discharge monitoring point.

12. BACKFILLING AND GRADING

The #1 Adit and substations located in Hardscrabble and Sowbelly canyons have been reclaimed. Hydro seeding and mulching will be completed at the Adit during the week of December 16, 2002.

21. BONDING AND INSURANCE

The surety bond is currently set at \$601,333.00 and the Certificate of Insurance is current through June 30, 2003.
