

**1. Was data submitted for all required monitoring sites?** YES [ X ] NO [ ]

The Castle Gate Mine is inactive, mostly reclaimed, and is awaiting appropriate conditions to apply for Phase II Bond Release. Water quality samples are to be collected and analyzed quarterly at four surface water monitoring sites located in Hardscrabble and Sowbelly Canyons. There are no UPDES sites remaining for the former mine. Water monitoring data is evaluated by the Division from the data that is submitted quarterly by the mine to the Division EDI database. The water monitoring plan is presented in Section 7.5-1, Surface Water Monitoring, of the mine's MRP (p. 7-57). Water quality parameters are outlined in Table 7-16 of the mine's MRP.

**Surface** *Sampling is required quarterly for four ephemeral stream monitoring sites (B-11, B-12, B-45, and B-28).*

No flow was reported for all four ephemeral stream monitoring sites.

Not required. The permittee has applied for a Phase I bond release.
