Report summary and status for pending enforcement actions, permit conditions, Division Orders, and amendments:

The Permittee notified the Division on May 7, 2007 that the required first quarter of 2007 surface water monitoring information for the Castle Gate Mine was in the DOGM EDI pipeline and was acceptable for uploading. All sites were monitored at the end of March and were reported as "no flow". The Permittee continues to meet the Special Condition included as Attachment "A" of the current State permit. There are no other "special" permit conditions. The field conditions in Sowbelly and Hardscrabble Canyons remain virtually unchanged, as does the condition of the reclaimed area for Adit #1.
