Water monitoring was submitted to the Division for the fourth quarter of 2009.

The reclaim refuse pile was inspected on March 19, 2009. No hazardous conditions were reported.

Rocky Mountain Power had steel wire and other non-coal waste material on and next to the reclaim area. Permittee will see that Rocky Mountain Power will pick-up this material.
