RE: Supplemental Data to NPDES Permit UT-0023540

Dear Mr. Burm:

On March 8, 1979 Coastal States Energy Company submitted an "Application for Permit to Discharge Wastewater" for its subsidiary Utah Fuel Company mining operation located south of Scofield, Utah. On December 21, 1979 an addendum to the application was filed requesting a permit for a second discharge from a loadout area sedimentation pond. Both requests were granted under NPDES permit UT-0023540.

At the time of the original filings, the data required in Part V of Application Form 2C could not be provided because the facility was still in the planning stage. Construction of both sedimentation ponds was completed during the summer of 1980, however, a precipitation event of sufficient magnitude to cause a discharge did not occur until late September of this year.

While the duration of this first discharge was only a few hours, water quality samples were obtained and have been analyzed by a certified laboratory. In fulfillment of our agreement as stated in your correspondence of October 10, 1980, the data for those discharges is attached

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on copies of Application Form 2C. The amount of data submitted reflects the modification granted in your correspondence of December 29, 1980.
