
Dear Mr. Young:

Referring to your letter of December 1, 1982, pertaining to Getty Mining Company's proposed coal exploration program (CEP/007/005), we address the State's concerns as follows:

1. Specific information relating to access road construction will be best determined during the onsite inspection of the proposed sites to be conducted next spring when weather permits. At that time, details of construction will be finalized and forwarded to the State.
- 2 & 3. We will incorporate the requirements of UMC 815.15(e) and (g) into stipulations for the final approval.
4. All holes will be plugged according to standard MMS requirements. A copy of these requirements will be included with the approval.
5. The surface management agency, the U. S. Forest Service, will stipulate a reclamation program for the proposed sites and access roads. This information will be forwarded to the State when available.
