Dear Mr. Carter;

This letter is to confirm our recent phone conversation on August 9, 1982. As we discussed, reclamation of the 1981 exploratory drill sites is to be conducted by Mr. Jack Otani of Clear Creek in accordance with your notice of intent to explore dated October 7, 1981, and approved on October 8, 1981. Seeding of recontoured areas should be done during the first favorable planting season (Fall 1982). Drill sites and mud pits on the north and south side of Winter Quarters Canyon Creek are in need of reclamation. One 1980 drill hole (#3 on map) needs to be sealed with cement as specified in your 1980 notice of intent to explore and the summary of the exploration program, dated December 4, 1980. This hole was found open on August 5, 1982.

Areas to be excluded from the reclamation work will include the drill hole to be used as a culinary water supply and the pad constructed to drill laterally into the old workings of Winter Quarters Mine. However, mud pits in these areas should be backfilled and recontoured. Due to the status of these areas and associated roads and the fact exploratory drilling has been completed and reclamation work initiated, you should submit a notification of completion and a description of reclamation activities as required in your October 8, 1981 approval to explore.

A letter and map should be submitted to the Division [UMC 776.11 (3)] detailing the variation from the original plan in your notice of intent. The locations of the actual drill hole sites should be marked on a 1:24,000 map. Any holes being used for water monitoring should also be noted. The access road to the south side of Winter Quarters Canyon Creek also deviates from the initial plans and should be redrawn on the new map. A narrative is needed

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detailing plans for the drilling and reclamation of the lateral exploration pad and associated road and plans for the culinary water well. Should you have any problems or questions feel free to contact me.
