Seismic Points SM-82-1&2 described in the Notice of Intent received October 1, 1982, were inspected by Sandy Pruitt on August 16, 1983. Seismic testing was completed in late fall 1982. The only surface effects which are detectable at this time is the cuttings in and around the major drill hole at each of the two test sites. The drill holes did not appear to have been cemented and were not marked with a metal tag as indicated in the Notice of Intent, but may have collapsed in blasting as the holes were not open at the time of this inspection. The test sites are adequately revegetated with Timothy grass, Intermediate wheatgrass, and Smooth brome. No additional reclamation is necessary.
