

On October 21, 1983, DOGM Field Specialist, Ken Wyatt conducted an inspection at the proposed Scofield Mine Project Development area. The purpose of this inspection was to examine the revegetation success of the 1981 drill sites that were reclaimed in the fall 1982.

Three sites located on Winter Quarters Ridge on the north side of the canyon were examined. The revegetation success looks good considering that sheep grazing does occur here. No problems were apparent from this inspection and all sites examined are stabilized.

The road up through Winter Quarters Canyon was severely damaged from the high spring runoff this year. It should be noted that the road through the canyon has been repaired and regraded all the way to the top of the ridge. This work was probably done by the landowner or Western Outdoorsmans since these people lease the land for hunting and fishing privileges. It should also be pointed out that several new roads have been constructed leading north from Winter Quarters Ridge to Woods Canyon from the ridge top road. These roads are bladed trails through the woods. Again this work appears to be the landowners or Western Outdoorsman. UCO is currently in the process of filing for Chapter 11 Bankruptcy, The status and potential for development of this mine in the near future is very questionable at this time.
