The above-mentioned mine operation was inspected by Sandy Pruitt and Lynn Kunzler, accompanied by Keith Zobell, Utah Fuel Company, on October 3, 1985. During this inspection, abatement measures for NOV #N85-2-16-2 were examined.

In abatement to NOV #1 of 2, a mine identification sign containing all required information was in place and clearly visible at the waste rock disposal pit. The sign was reportedly in place immediately following issuance of the NOV on August 30, 1985.

In abatement of NOV #2 of 2, the diversion ditch along the sediment disposal trench was well established, reportedly as of September 11, 1985. DOGM is currently reviewing the design specifications for the drainage ditch, received September 24, 1985. Since the diversion ditch appeared functionally adequate, NOV #2 of 2 was terminated as a result of this inspection.

Sediments placed in the waste rock disposal pit are drying out. Keith Zobell mentioned that Utah Fuel will attempt to manipulate the sediments to reestablish a road to the west end of the disposal pit before winter.

A silt fence has been installed along the railcar loadout small area exemption to provide alternate sediment control as required by DOGM.
