A partial inspection of the Skyline Mine was conducted by Sandy Pruitt on July 12, 1985. Keith Zobell accompanied this inspector on a brief tour of the mine operation. All abatement measures required by NOV #2 of 2, N85-2-9-2 were adequately completed with the exception of Area C. The blocked culvert on the downspout of the undisturbed diversion above the south side of the material storage yard will be repaired with an elbow secured to the unblocked section of culvert and a half round culvert extended down to the toe of the slope. Utah Fuel requested an extension until August 10, 1985 to allow time necessary to obtain the elbow for a downspout and complete the necessary repairs. This extension was granted in a modification dated July 12, 1985.

In abatement to NOV #1 of 2, N85-2-9-2, Keith Zobell presented a purchase order for buffer zone markers dated June 25, 1985. The markers are not available yet, therefore, the NOV was extended one week until July 19, 1985 to allow time necessary to post the signs as required.
