A partial inspection was conducted at the above mentioned mine site on June 13, 1985 by Barton Kale of the Division. The inspector was accompanied by Bob Lauman of Plateau Mining Company.

An inspection of the upper pad (Lion Deck) revealed that the ditch behind the shop had been fully cleaned and maintained as designed. Snow was still drifted in as of the last inspection at this location. The undisturbed ditch behind the equipment stockpile had not received its yearly maintenance yet and the operator was informed that he had until the next inspection to have that done.

The rest of the Lion Deck area was in satisfactory condition.

The Star Point Mine area is continuing to be cleaned and sealed. Some modifications to the reclamation plan may become necessary as the company starts to delineate their yearly reclamation, schedule and prepare for their 5 year resubmittal.

Other areas of inspection included the underflow ponds and the new coal pile by the rail loadout. No problems were noted at this time.
