The enclosed Notice of Violation, NOV #N85-2-16-2, is a result of my inspection of the Skyline mine on August 28, 1985. We discussed NOV #1 of 2, regarding the mine identification sign at the waste rock disposal pit, at the conclusion of the inspection.

NOV #2 of 2 results from Utah Fuel Company's failure to divert surface runoff away from the sediment disposal area at the railroad loadout. A diversion was part of the approved design specifications for the sediment disposal site, and is required by UMC 817.72(d).

I was unable to contact you over the phone earlier today, to discuss this enforcement action. Please call me if you have any questions or problems in abating either violation by September 6, 1985.
