ACT/007/005, Folder #7, Carbon County, Utah

In reference to your letter dated July 19, 1985, please find attached the termination notice for Notice of Violation #N84-2-24-3, #2 of 3 with the following stipulations:

1. Utah Fuel Company will submit to the Division a survey and contour map of the sediment pond (with two foot contour intervals) before September 15, 1985 (no such map presently exists). The survey and map must be certified by a registered professional engineer.
2. Utah Fuel Company will be allowed to discharge a mine water volume of 240,000 GPD into the existing sediment pond. This approved volume is conditional upon verification by the Division of the pond volume following receipt of item #1. If Utah Fuel needs to discharge more than 240,000 GPD of mine water, you must contact the Division. The Division will designate a monitoring program to handle the excess discharge.
3. Utah Fuel Company will install and maintain water discharge recording equipment provided by the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining for a minimum of 120 days. At which time the data will be evaluated. The equipment, as described by Randy Harden in a phone conversation with Keith Zobell on Wednesday, July 31, 1985, will consist of a Rustrak Strip Chart Recorder, Model #288, to be installed at or near the existing flow meter within two weeks of date of receipt.
