ACT/007/005, #3 and #4, Carbon County, Utah


The Division has reviewed Utah Fuel's latest submission dated February 19, 1985 which addresses technical deficiencies identified pursuant to the Division's letter of February 7, 1985.

Your recent responses are adequate to address the Division's previous concerns. The Company is hereby granted conditional approval to utilize this area for temporary waste rock storage in accordance with the provisions identified in the proposal. As a condition to final approval, the Division requests an additional thirteen (13) copies of the final approved plans submitted in format which will allow direct insertion into the current Mining and Reclamation Plan on file with the regulatory agencies. Each copy should reference by page number and volume those sections, text and maps which are to be replaced from the original MRP. Please provide this information to the Division by April 15, 1985.
