Dear Mr. Braxton:

The Utah Preservation Office has received for consideration the above referenced mine plan. As outlined in our Divisions' Memorandum of Agreement, our office has reviewed the submittal and has the following comments for consideration.

In Volume I, on page 2-204, there is statement that says there are no known archeological or paleontological sites within the proposed area. They probably should reference the letter received from our office and the AERC survey to support that statement.

In Volume III, page 4-65, there is an indication that there will be no effect by the project as it now stands, if there are any sites found, the mine company will contact proper authorities. We believe that this is the correct procedure, and would recommend to DOGM that the mine plan has covered those areas required by the Office of Surface Mining concerning cultural resources.
