In response to your request for information on water and updated list of corporation officers, we are submitting the following information.

Records show that Utah Fuel Company augmented the Colorado River drainage system as follows:

Discharge Mine Water	220 Ac. ft.
Water pumped from Wells	-30.8 Ac. ft.
Evaporation from Sediment ponds	<u>-1.25 Ac. ft.</u>
Total Augmentation	187.95 Ac. ft.

The evaporation from the sedimentation pond was calculated for us by Kaiser Engineering. Their calculations correlate closely with the NOAA data.

This information is to update through revision or supplementation, the corporate information originally filed in Volume 1, Chapter 2 of the Skyline Mining and Reclamation Plan.

The Skyline properties were acquired (100% ownership) by Coastal States Energy Company (CSEC) in March, 1978. During 1979 a 50% interest in the properties was conveyed to Getty Mineral Resources Company (GMRC) pursuant to a Joint Venture agreement between CSEC and GMRC. GMRC, a Delaware corporation, was a wholly owned subsidiary of Getty Oil Company. Subsequently, the Joint Venture parties submitted and received approval of the Skyline Mining and Reclamation Plan.

In October, 1985, CSEC purchased 100% of the stock of GMRC. Since then, Coastal has reorganized its coal division, resulting in different officers of the various Coastal subsidiaries. Also, on January 20, 1986, the name of GMRC was changed to Skyline Energy Company.

As now exists, CSEC is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Coastal Corporation, a Delaware corporation, with address at Nine Greenway Plaza, Houston, Texas 77046. The officers of CSEC are as follows:


