
Re: Mine Water Discharge Strip Recorder Operation

Dear Mr. Braxton:

On September 16, 1985, Randy Harden from your staff visited the Skyline Mine for the purpose of initial startup of the mine water discharge strip chart recorder which had been furnished by the Division. Mr. Harden also hand-delivered your September 13, 1985 memo and operating procedures for the Rustrak 288 strip chart recorder.

We had operated the recorder since September 16, 1985. On January 20, 1986 we removed the 30 day chart from the recorder. This strip chart will meet or exceed the 120 day or 2400 hours required in your September 13, 1985 operating procedures. We have shut your recorder off and are returning it to you along with the latest strip chart and data sheet. With this strip chart and data sheet, along with the ones submitted to your office in October, November, and December 1985, we have met the commitments in your September 16, 1985 memo. We will have Keith Welch of our Midvale Office pick up the recorder and deliver it to your office so it will be available to you for other projects.
