Your proposal for minor modification of the approved mine plan was received by this office January 10, 1986 and has been reviewed.

The large quantity of water being pumped from the section has been verified by the Mining Engineer of this office, and the operational problems this causes are understood. The proposal to mine a sump, approximately 20 feet by 100 feet, would be in the Second North barrier pillar and will have no adverse affect on the recoverability of the coal reserves.
