RE: Status of Conditional Approval, Sedimentation Pond
Cleanout, Utah Fuel Company, Skyline Mine ACT/007/005,
Carbon County, Utah

The above referenced approval has been an ongoing issue since early January, 1986. The following correspondance history is relevant to this issue:

1-15-86: DOGM conditional approval for the modification of diversion BC-12. Requested acceptance of condition and 10 copies of proposal.

1-21-86: Response from Skyline that they will provide comment on this issue following the outcome of a scheduled assessment conference.

2-13-86: DOGM clarified the issue for Skyline. The action is related to the modification approval process and is not related to enforcement action. February 20, 1986 deadline given for response.

2-20-86: Skyline informed DOGM that the above requested response deadline could not be met due to power outages at the mine.

4-28-86: Skyline response received. They commit to lining the diversion with two inch ballast material (the proposal is still deficient in some design details). They consider the matter complete with this response.

5-5-86: DOGM clarifies the diversion design specifics required. Requested ten copies for plan insertion.

No response has been received by the Division to date relative to this approval. I have reviewed the recently submitted five-year permit application and it appears that this information has not been incorporated into the application. Information on diversions is generally deficient in the application, therefore I recommend that we incorporate this issue into the upcoming review process.
