RE: MRP Amendment, Stoker Coal Circuit Proposal, Submittal of July 23, 1986, Utah Fuel Company, Skyline Mine, ACT/007/005-86D, Carbon County, Utah

SUMMARY

The surface water hydrology sections of the above referenced plans were reviewed. The proposed plan consists of adding a stoker coal circuit to the existing coal storage and railroad loadout area adjacent to Highway 96. The new facilities include a stoker screening system, covered conveyor, stoker oil tank, stoker coal storage bin and a covered truck scale. In addition, the existing graveled road will be paved and a truck loop will be added to provide access to and from the scales. All proposed facilities are located within the disturbed area boundaries. Portions of the existing access road and proposed truck loop are located in an area which was previously approved by the Division as a small area exemption. The addition of a paved road surface will reduce the amount of erodable material in the exempt area and enhance the routing of stream flow to the catch basins located on either side of the roadway.
