Here is the condition and production of the reference areas that we visited.

The Aspen site is in high good to low excellent condition and the production is about 3,000 lbs/acre.

The riparian area is in fair condition. The site is producing about 3,000 lbs/acre.

The sagebrush grass site is in high fair condition. The production is about 1,800 lbs/acre.

The spruce-fir site is a woodland site and the understory vegetation is sparse because of dense overstory. The production of the understory is about 150 lbs/acre. The site is in good condition.

The Scofield rock disposal site is in low good condition. The site production is about 2,000 lbs/acre.
