The Utah Preservation Office has received for consideration the above mentioned amended five year plan for the Skyline Mine. After review our office has the following comments.

We concur with the recommendations that: 1) Sites 42Cb333 and 42Cb334 be avoided by construction and personnel; and 2) Site 42Cb1306 be tested in order to determine if it is eligible for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places.

If the above recommendations are followed, and site 42Cb1306 is avoided or mitigated if determined eligible, a determination of no adverse effect would be appropriate.
