Re: Approval of PAP Amendment, Enlargement of Portal Area  
Sedimentation Pond/Decant Modification, Utah Fuel Company,  
Skyline Mine, ACT/007/005-87A, Folder #3, Carbon County, Utah

The Division received your conditional approval responses to the PAP amendment referenced above on October 22 and 29, 1987. The plan was reviewed by Rick Summers, Reclamation Hydrologist, and has been determined technically adequate for final approval. Please refer to the attached technical memorandum for an explanation of the technical assessment of the latest revised plans. This approval applies only to the modification for the increase of the sediment pond spillway height. The spillway/discharge system is adequately sized to handle the design discharge.

This letter will serve as the Division's final approval for this permit change application. Utah Fuel Company has now adequately addressed all of the conditions required by this office to finalize this permit amendment. The extra copies of the approved plans will now be distributed to the appropriate agencies to update the approved PAP's. Thank you for your cooperation in completing this permitting activity.
