However, the Division feels that settleable solids and dissolved oxygen should be added to the Eccles Creek stream stations on Table 2.3.7-2 and nitrite should be added to the Eccles Creek outfall, mine water discharge(s), and sedimentation pond stations (CS-2, CS-12, CS-14, NPDES point).
