
Re: Response to Stipulation UMC 817.46-1-RS, Sedimentation Pond Design

In your letter of June 26, 1990 the Division granted an extension of time to complete the above mentioned stipulation to October 1, 1990.

As outlined in our May 30, 1990 letter we have sealed off the North Mains in Mine #3. We expected this area to be filled by the 1st part of October when we would again pump the excess water to the sedimentation pond. The area in the North Mains has filled at a slower rate than expected. We currently expect it to take another 4-6 weeks before we begin to pump water from the North Mains.

Since the North Mains is the major water producing area, we feel that it is not proper for us to do the calculation on the sediment pond design without the flow information from the North Mains. We are therefore requesting an extension of time be allowed until December 14, 1990 for us to properly respond to the above mentioned stipulation.
