Dear Mr. Thompson:

In accordance with the conditions of NPDES Discharge Permit UT-0023540, Part II - A-2 and Utah Mining Code Section 817.52(b)(i)(ii), Utah Fuel Company is herewith providing the required written notification of a failure to comply with the maximum effluent limitation for sulfate at the 001 discharge point.

The problem occurred with the sample taken September 13, 1990, which had a sulfate concentration of 515 mg/l. This concentration exceeds the 500 mg/l limitation established in the current NPDES discharge permit. The laboratory report was received on October 18, 1990.
