Re: Coal Stacking Tube Amendment, Skyline Mine, Coastal States  
Energy Company, ACT/007/005-90A, Carbon County, Utah

In recent discussions with our Associate Director, Lowell Braxton, it was brought to my attention that miscommunication may have occurred between the U.S. Forest Service and DOGM regarding the Skyline mine coal stacking tube amendment. DOGM personell have been in phone contact with Forest Service personell, but perhaps this has not been adequate. In hopes of correcting this problem, I am forwarding to you a copy of our correspondence related to this amendment.

At this time, it appears that most of the DOGM concerns have been adequately addressed. On May 17, 1990, the Division issued a conditional approval to commence construction of the new facilities provided that all construction be limited to areas that were previously disturbed. No new disturbance has been approved.

There still appears to be some confusion between the USFS and the Division of Wildlife Resources regarding the design of a stilling basin to be put in at the head of the bypass culvert. Upon resolution of this design the Division is prepared to issue final approval for the amendment. Please keep us informed of the Forest Service desires concerning this project.
