Dear Mr. Reed:

In accordance with the conditions of NPDES Discharge Permit UT-0023540, Part II - A-2 and Utah Mining Code Section 817.52(b)(i)(ii), Utah Fuel Company is herewith providing the required written notification of a failure to comply with the maximum effluent limitations for TDS and for Total Iron at the 001 discharge point.

The problem occurred with the sample taken December 18, 1990, which had a TDS concentration of 1008 mg/l. This concentration exceeds the 1000 mg/l daily maximum limitation established in the current NPDES discharge permit. The Total Iron concentration was 4.03 mg/l, which exceeds the discharge limitation of 2.0 mg/l. The laboratory report was received on January 17, 1991.
