Re: Coal Stockpile Amendment

We have revised pages 3-22 & 3-22a to reflect the protection of the slopes as agreed to in the joint meeting with the U.S. Forest Service and DOGM. We have enclosed 14 copies of these pages. We have also enclosed for your review a draft of the coal recovery plan at the new stack tube.

We feel the information on page 3-64D is correct and does not need to be changed. Area 2, which we call "the South Fork of Eccles Creek," is the south or left fork of main Eccles Creek here on the permitted minesite. Further downstream on the main Eccles Creek there is a creek named South Fork. We have changed map no. 3.2.1-1 to identify the alternate sediment control area in the Middle Fork as area No. 3 and have enclosed 14 copies.

Before the coal pile reaches its fullest boundaries, 10 ft. high fence post will be placed in strategic locations around the upper edge of the pile. These fence posts will be color coded so that the thickness of the coal left on the existing highwall will be indicated.

Coal will not be recovered any closer than 18" to these highwalls under normal circumstances. Under emergency situations, this coal may need to be recovered. If so, we shall provide an assigned person to monitor the work being performed, so as to insure that the highwall is not disturbed.
