Dear Mr. Reed:

In accordance with the conditions of NPDES Discharge Permit UT-0023540, Part II - A-2 and Utah Mining Code Section 817.52(b)(i)(ii), Utah Fuel Company is herewith providing the required written notification of a failure to comply with the maximum effluent limitation for Oil and Grease at the 001 discharge point.

The problem occurred with the sample taken February 20, 1991, which had an Oil and Grease concentration of 13.1 mg/l. This concentration exceeds the 10 mg/l limitation established in the current NPDES discharge permit. The laboratory report was received on March 11, 1991.
