Dear Mr. Haddock:

During a recent meeting Division personnel indicated that we could submit any resource information that we have assembled on our forthcoming overland conveyor permit amendment. We are therefore submitting the following resource information: Three copies each of 1) SCS soil map; 2) SCS soil survey description as published in "Soil Survey of Carbon Area" issued by U.S.D.A.-SCS, June 1988; 3) 28 Sept. 1990 letter from Endangered Plant Studies, Inc. reviewing the results of their plant T&E survey; 4) 31 Jan. 1991 letter from Endangered Plant Studies, Inc., transmitting the vegetative information and map, the additional soil information and map, and a statement concerning prime agricultural land along the proposed route; 5) Vegetative report; 6) Vegetative maps (series of four); 7) Site specific soils report; 8) Site specific soils maps (series of four); and 9) Two reports from the Archaeological-Environmental Research Corp. on the Archaeological and Historical search of the area.

We have not conducted an additional Wildlife T&E survey as we feel the initial T&E survey done on the original permit adequately covered the area. We will be contracting with a consulting firm in the near future to do the hydrologic consequence report for us.

We have received tentative bids for the various conveyor proposals and are in the process of evaluating them. As soon as one proposal is selected we will proceed with the remainder of the permit amendment documentation and submit it to your office for review.
