Dear ~~Mr.~~ Haddock,

Enclosed is our application for a permit change for the construction of our overland conveyor system from the mine site to the railroad loadout area. We have done extensive engineering investigation to determine the selection of this conveyor system and feel that it represents the soundest environmental and engineering design that is currently available.

We have had several reviews of the system with Utah Division of Wildlife Resources and feel we have met or exceeded all of their concerns and requirements. We are also in the process of submitting an application to the Utah Division of Air Quality for a permit change to include this conveyor system.

Our original permit application for the Skyline Mines included bonding for the construction of the overland conveyor system. The original bonding included several transfer stations which will not be constructed. The original bonding amount is more than sufficient to cover this new overland conveyor system.

The new disturbance for the system amounts to an additional .18 acres. This small disturbance is because from the end of the already constructed conveyor bench to the railroad loadout area the conveyor will be built on supporting towers. Each tower will disturb an area approximately 10' X 10'. The towers will be constructed using cranes from the adjacent state highway.
