Dear Mr. Haddock:

In the original planning for the Skyline Mine it was projected that we could have up to approximately 800 employees. During the early stages of development only part of the facilities in the Operations/Maintenance complex were completed. We are now approaching 350 employees and have run out of shower and locker space. We are in the process of putting together a contract to finish additional shower and locker space. We expect this construction to start approximately May 1, 1991 and be completed by July 30, 1991.

Until this construction is finished we are in need of temporary additional lockers and shower space. We would like to request approval to move onto our minesite a shower/locker trailer to meet these needs. We have enclosed a map showing the location where we would put this trailer. The trailer would be a 14 x 52' unit, grey in color with red trim. We would bring domestic water and electricity from our existing office/maintenance complex into the trailer. The waste water from the trailer would be dumped into the existing waste lines and collection system. We would like to move this unit onto the permit area on 3-11-91 and would remove the unit from the site by 9-15-91.

We would appreciate your early review and approval of this request.
