This letter responds to your request of November 26, 1991, wherein you asked that you be allowed to address the subsidence issue as part of your M&RP renewal which is due on December 31, 1991. I discussed your request with Aaron Howe of the Forest Service and he seemed amenable to the idea as long as the scope of your mine plan changes are not of the magnitude that it would tie up the renewal process. You are hereby authorized to provide the required information to address the subsidence issue on or before December 31, 1991.

In the mean time you should consider the installation of the flumes and the corresponding water monitoring plan to be approved and data should be in the process of being collected. The sooner data is supplied to us and the Forest Service, the better your position will be for having your plans approved.

The subsidence issue must be resolved. As you are aware, April 30, 1992 is the date for your permit renewal. We encourage you to make every effort to complete the resolution prior to that date. We will be happy to meet with you or provide other assistance as possible.
