RE: Permit Amendment-Resubmittal

Dear Mr. Haddock:

Attached is our resubmittal for the permit amendment for the construction of our overland conveyor. We have attached new maps 3.2.3-2, 3.2.3-2b, 3.2.3-2c and maps 3.2.3-3 through 3.2.3-3f.

We are still waiting for some information from our consultants, and will submit it as soon as it is received.

Map 3.2.1-1 has been revised to show the drainage from the docking area, which will now report to the sedimentation pond. This area amounts to .18 acres, which is an insignificant area, and should have no measurable effect on the functioning of the sediment pond. The additional drainage will be handled by the ditch DD-12. Copy of the engineering calculations for this ditch are attached.

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Permit Amendement - Resubmittal

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As we field checked this drainage area, we found that the original drainage, previously shown reporting to the sediment has changed. This is due to the slide area above the crusher building, which has changed the drainage pattern, and an additional 1.17 acres are reporting to the pond. This area has been identified as area ARA-1A. Since this change is not tied to the overland conveyor, we will make a separate submittal to correct our permit renewal application.

We have not changed our bonding calculations, as the original permit, which included the overland conveyor, included \$96,000 bonding. The overland conveyor, as designed, required bonding in the amount of \$72,862.00

As soon as final approval is received, we will make the necessary changes to the table of contents in the various volumns.

To the best of my knowledge, the information contained in this submittal is ture and accurate.


