SUBJECT: Permit Amendment - M&RP

Dear Mr. Haddock:

Due to a concrete failure on our No. 2 storage silo, Utah Fuel is requesting a permit amendment to change our approved M&RP to add a feeder hopper and a conveyor belt to reclaim the coal from our approved open coal storage area at the RRLO. This feeder and conveyor has Division of Air Quality approval for temporary use while we are repairing our coal storage silo (see attached letter). This change is necessary to allow us to reclaim the coal at a higher rate than originally anticipated.

Fourteen copies of new page 3-27, and Map 3.2.3-1A are enclosed.

On April 14, 1992, we submitted an updated surface facilities map for the RRLO, which included this new facility. In that submittal, we also showed the change in bonding. This submittal was approved on April 16, 1992.

The information in this request for permit amendment is true and correct based on our best information and knowledge.
