Dear Mr. Braxton:

Pursuant to Regulation 645-400-324 we are requesting an extension beyond the normal 90 day abatement time. This violation is also closely correlated with and regulated by the Utah Division of Health (DOH). An ongoing dialog is occurring with DOH to resolve the nature and remedial action of the violation.

TDS values of our NPDES discharge have steadily declined and are approaching acceptable limits.

The resolve of this violation is tied to the approval of DOH and, therefore, we are requesting an extension for the abatement until approval for remedial measures are approved by DOH.
