RE: RRLO OPEN COAL STORAGE PERMIT AMENDMENT

Attached are fourteen copies of Map 3.2.1-3 and pages 3-24, 3-24(a), 3-26, 3-26(a), 3-27, 3-27(a), 3-30, 3-30(a), 3-39, and 3-39(a) of the M&RP which been changed to update and add to our RRLO open coal storage area. We have changed the contours of the coal storage pad, added BC-12A, a portable tripper and stacking conveyor which runs along BC-12A, changed the location of DD-9, added a concrete lined channel for DD-9, rip rapped channel for energy dissipater for DD-9, eliminated SW-10, shown the MCC and dust collector bulging for the overland conveyor, added an operational sediment trap in DD-10, and corrected the labeling for DD-12. We have also included new calculations for DD-9 concrete section DD-8, 9, 10 and 11 and DD-12. We have also included new calculations for DD-9 concrete section, DD-8, 9, 10 and 11, and DD-12.

These changes will affect the reclamation bonds as indicated:

1. BC-12A (with hopper, feeder & belt)	\$1,320
2. BC-12A portable tripper and stacking conveyor	\$4,200
3. DD-9 Concrete Section	\$ 70


