## NOTICE OF PERMIT REVISION

To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Act (Utah Code Annotated 1953, Section 40-10-1 et seq), and the "Regulations Pertaining to Surface Effects of Underground Coal Mining Activities" (Final Rules of the Utah Board of Oil, Gas and Mining), the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining has issued a revised permanent program mining permit to Coastal States Energy Company for its permit application No. ACT/007/005. The revised permit incorporates an overland conveyor corridor into the permit area of the mine. The Company will construct, use and reclaim the overland conveyor in accordance with the approved Mining and Reclamation Plan for the Skyline Mine associated with the following lands:

Township 13 South, Range 7 East, SLBM

Beginning at the East end of the existing Permit boundary on the centerline of the conveyor, said point is in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 19. A corridor of land approximately 40 feet either side of this centerline; thence Easterly along said centerline of conveyor to the North boundary of said Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 19, thence Easterly along said centerline of conveyor to the East boundary of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 18, thence Easterly along said centerline of conveyor, thence Northeasterly along said centerline of conveyor to the East boundary of said Section 18, Thence Northeasterly along said centerline of conveyor to the East boundary of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, Thence Northeasterly along said centerline of conveyor to the East boundary of said Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, thence Easterly along said centerline of conveyor to the East boundary of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, thence Easterly along said centerline of conveyor to the head pulley.

The Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (Division) is granting approval and issuing a permanent program mining permit to Coastal States Energy Company for an Overland Conveyor associated with the Skyline Mine. The Division has determined that the permit application is technically complete and demonstrates compliance with all the "Regulations Pertaining to Surface Effects of Underground Coal Mining Activities, Final Rules of the Utah Board and Division of Oil, Gas and Mining," promulgated under the Utah Coal Mining Reclamation Act (Utah Code Annotated 1953, Section 40-10-1 et seq.).

Notice is hereby given to all appropriate agencies and individuals having jurisdiction over, or an interest in the area of the proposed operations, pursuant to R645-300-152, that a permit has been issued to said permittee.

This permit authorizes the permittee, Coastal States Energy Company, to construct, use and reclaim an overland conveyor system on the described lands within the permit area at the Skyline Mine site situated in the state of Utah, County of Carbon, subject to the terms of the approved Mining and Reclamation Plan, this permit, and all applicable laws and regulations. The new permit area for the conveyor is contained in the following described lands:

Township 13 South, Range 7 East, SLBM

Beginning at the East end of the existing Permit boundary on the centerline of the conveyor, said point is in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 19.
