**RE: NPDES PERMIT UT-0023540**

In accordance with conditions of NPDES Discharge Permit UT-0023540, Part II - I-3 and Utah Coal Mining Rules R645-301-731.223, Utah Fuel Company is herewith providing the required written notification of a failure to comply with the maximum effluent limitations for TDS at the 001 discharge point.

The problem occurred with the sample taken January 20, 1993, which had a TDS concentration of 1088 mg/l, and a sulfate concentration of 700 mg/l. These concentrations exceed the 1000 mg/l maximum limitation for TDS and the 500 mg/l maximum Sulfate limitation established in the current NPDES discharge permit. The laboratory report was received on February 1, 1993.
